Mesotherapy (mesoneedling, microneedling)

Mesotherapy (alternative names: mesoneedling, microneedling) is a great technique that allows you to preserve your natural beauty to a ripe old age. When it comes to skin rejuvenation treatment, most patients place great value on immediately visible results. But a lasting result needs time.

Microneedling causes skin microtrauma, while not damaging the epidermis between punctures, and takes advantage of the body's own cell regeneration. The treatment stimulates collagen production and causes new cells to be formed. This process is facilitated by a combination of medical active ingredients such as hyaluronic acid, minerals, vitamins, amino acids, and peptides. After approximately three procedures (one per month), the best results are achieved: the skin structure improves, with wrinkles smoothed out and facial lines reduced.

Mesotherapy is a gentle process that can nevertheless achieve a noticeable natural rejuvenation of the skin. Compared to surgery, this procedure is much less expensive, has few side effects and is almost painless. The skin, hair, and connective tissue are improved from the inside and maintained through dietary supplements and/or the use of external care products (e.g., hormonal or peptide creams, etc.). Yet, even mesotherapy has its limits: optimal results can only be achieved when the affected anatomical structures, such as hair roots, remain intact. Like any other naturopathic technique, mesotherapy can only help where the body's restorative mechanisms are still effective. A certain lifestyle and various factors such as diet, physical exercises, smoking, drinking alcohol, UV radiation, etc., can greatly affect the skin and its appearance, as well as the response to treatment.

Mesolift

Mesolift (also mesoglow) is an effective treatment method for the skin's intensive revitalising and smoothing. Through mesotherapy, you can significantly increase the moisture content in the skin and delay its ageing. Fine lines disappear, dry and tired skin begins to shine again.

Natural hyaluronic acid with a non-mesh structure and a combination of selected growth components, vitamins, minerals, amino acids, and antioxidants moisturise the skin and facilitate the formation of new collagen and elastic fibres. Mesolift consists of introducing skin rejuvenating substances along the skin folds and over the entire surface of the face, neck, decollete area, and back of the hands.

Mesolift is most painless when using an electronic microneedling device. If necessary, you can apply an analgesic cream before starting a mesolift session. This method, which originally came from France and is based on completely natural active ingredients, has recently become increasingly widespread and has found countless followers not only in Hollywood. The best result can be achieved after 3 or 4 treatments given once a month.

Mesohair

Mesohair is an amazing new treatment for weak hair growth or hair loss. A revitalising cocktail delivered into the skin during a Mesohair session stimulates hair roots and facilitates their regeneration. Any type of hair loss can be stopped with Mesohair. If hair roots are still "alive," then the resumption and steady growth of hair begins, which is often accompanied by an improvement in their condition and an increase in their thickness.

Retreatment schedule:

- Initial phase: 4 sessions with an interval of 1 week
- Further treatment: 4 sessions per month
- Long-term treatment: 4 sessions per year

With Mesohair, new hair usually becomes visible after 3 months. Please wash your hair before starting the procedure, and avoid colouring or perming for 24 hours afterwards. Mesohair simultaneously treats possible problems such as dandruff or seborrhea.
